Covid 19 Guidelines for Mass

- Those who are sick or have any symptoms of or confirmed COVID-19 should stay at home.
- Three people in every second seat.
- 2 Couples or a Family per seat
- Keep kneelers up / Stay sitting or standing
- Practise good cough and sneeze etiquette
- We must ensure that the required physical distance is maintained during all liturgies,
- Extra people can listen in their car outside Church.
- Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand only after Mass.
- All people are advised to wear masks
- Boxes will be placed at entrance of the Church for contribution envelopes, to avoid the need for people to pass collection baskets or bags.
- **Maximum number allowed is as follows:**
Crossmolina: 100 + Eskeragh: 38 +
Keenagh: 50 + Kilmurry: 40 +
- Mass on Friday's at 12 Noon for Senior Citizens.
- No weekday Masses in Eskeragh, Keenagh, Kilmurry. Masses already booked will be transferred to the weekend.
- Leave spaces at front doors for people to listen to Mass from speakers

Extra Cleaners & Stewarts are required for weekday & Sunday Masses
