### 2024 Tax Rebate—CHY4 Certs

CHY4 Certs are now available at all Church porches. If you wish a copy to be posted/emailed to you, please contact the Parish Office. Deadline for completion, 16th May 2025. Please return to the designated postal boxes, collection boxes or return to the Parish Office by post or scan and email.

The CHY4 from allows the Parish to claim tax back on donations made within a specific year of €250+. If you are a taxpayer, simply complete the form and return it to the Parish Office. Your donation will be worth an additional 44.93%. So, if you donate €250, we can claim €112.33 tax back from Revenue, meaning your original donation is worth €362.33 to the Parish. Your details will remain confidential to the Parish and Revenue. The information will not be used for anything other than the tax claim and does not affect your tax status in any way.
